The Lilac Burmese is my passion and I bred the first Lilac Supreme Champion in 1995 - Sp Ch Zion Princess Zona. Some of my breeding have qualified for COTY over the years and I am particularly proud of our lilac girl, Sp Ch Zion Amandla, who was third in 2001. I am also proud to state that by importing cats from Australia, I assisted in improving the type and eye colour of the Burmese in South Africa. I also encouraged other Burmese breeders to do the same and today the Burmese are winning Best in Shows all over the country.
